


The College is named after Maharaja Manindra Chandra Nandy of Cossimbazar, a philanthropist and reformist during the period of Bengal Renaissance.





## UG ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA, 2025-2026

- A candidate who passed the Higher Secondary or its equivalent Examination (10+2 level) in or after 2022 is eligible to apply for admission to the undergraduate courses.
- A candidate must have passed in English (full marks not being less than 100) in the previous qualifying examination to apply for B.A / B.Sc./B.Com courses.
- Admission will be conducted strictly on the basis of merit. The subject wise merit lists will be prepared based on corresponding INDEX MARK for all categories of students.
- SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/EWS candidates from West Bengal having original certificate are eligible for reservation benefits.
- Admission to any course of the college is provisional and is subject to the final approval of the University of Calcutta.
- Anti-ragging declaration as mandated by the UGC is to be furnished by every student after admission.
- There is no hostel facility in the college.
- Merit Lists for all subjects, Admission Schedule and all Admission Notices will be published on college website [www.mmccollege.co.in](http://www.mmccollege.co.in). No separate communication regarding merit lists will be made to the candidates individually.

Admission to the Three Years/Four Years B.A./ B.Sc. /B.Com. Courses of Studies in CCF System under the University of Calcutta will be guided by Admission and Examination Regulations (Notification No. CSR/04/2023 dated 23.06.2023, CSR/05/2023 dated 23.06.2023 & CSR/06/2023 dated 23.06.2023 of the University of Calcutta.

### **Applicability of the regulation:**

These regulation shall be applicable to:

- a. The students who are taking admission to the B.A /B.Sc /B.Com.(Honours/ MDC) Course from the academic session 2024-25.
- b. Students who have already successfully completed any U.G. degree earlier are not eligible to take admission into above course.
- c. However, no student shall be allowed admission after a lapse of more than 3 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. (Explanation: The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating three years from the year of passing the previous qualifying Examination).

*For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com/B.Mus. (Honours/ MDC)Courses, aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate. Marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. However, if the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.*

Eligibility criteria of application for admission in B.A/ B.Sc. Honours:

1. A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate (**of best 4 subjects excluding compulsory Environmental Education or Studies**) and 45% marks in the Major subject or related subject in the pre qualifying examinations

**OR**

2. 50% marks in the aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.

**OR**

3. 55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination

Eligibility criteria of application for admission in B. Com Honours:

A candidate taking up B.Com. Honours Course must have obtained

1. A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the major subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

**OR**

2. 55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

## Marks Criteria for S.C./S.T. candidates as per C.U. Rules

1. 40% in the aggregate or subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination, for all Major courses.
2. Passed in 10+2 or equivalent examination for all MDC courses.

Seat reservation for admission in the first year class of degree courses of studies shall be guided by the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission), Act, 2013 and the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Rules, 2014 and Memorandum No. 339-Edn (CS)/OM-74L/2023, dt. 26.05.2023.

***Details of Eligibility for Admission in Major subjects given below in the Table (in addition to 50% aggregate in top 4 subjects)***

<b>Computer Science</b>	Passed in Mathematics and any one of the Physics/ Statistics/ Computer Science with 50% marks in aggregate (If studied Computer science in (10+2) level obtained 45% marks in Computer science)
<b>Bengali</b>	45% in Bengali
<b>English</b>	45% in English
<b>Hindi</b>	45% in Hindi
<b>History</b>	45% in History (If not studied History, aggregate 50% only)
<b>Political Science</b>	45% in Political Science (If not studied Political Science, aggregate 50% only)
<b>Philosophy</b>	45% (If not studied Philosophy, then Psychology/Math/Education/Sociology/Political Science can be treated as related subjects)
<b>Journalism and Mass Communication</b>	-----
<b>Commerce</b>	45% in subject or related subject

**Eligibility criteria of application for admission in General Degree Courses:- B.A, B.Sc, B.Com.**

A candidate shall be allowed to take up the subject(s) (as Major or Minor) under heading “A” if he/she had passed the subject(s) under heading “B” at the previous qualifying examination. This will not be applicable for IDC subjects.

## Special conditions for admission to the following Major Courses9

- 1. Economics :** A Candidate shall be allowed to take up in Major Economics if he/she has passed in Mathematics at the H.S. Examination (10+2) conducted by the West Bengal Council of H.S. Education or its equivalent examination in Mathematics/ Business Mathematics. Students who have passed Business Economics including Business Mathematics in H.S. (10+2) level from West Bengal Council of H.S. Education are also eligible for admission in the Major Course in Economics. Candidates of Economics Major have to take up Mathematics as one of the elective subjects.
- 2. Mathematics:** A candidate shall be allowed to take up in Major Mathematics if he/she has passed in Mathematics at the previous qualifying examination. A candidate who has passed in Business Mathematics is not eligible for admission to the Mathematics Major Course.
- 3. Chemistry:** A candidate shall be allowed to take up in Major Chemistry if he/she has passed in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at the previous qualifying examination.
- 4. Computer Science:** The combination of subjects for Computer Science Major Course shall be Mathematics as one of the General subjects and any one of the following subjects: either Physics or Statistics or Electronics.
- 5. Philosophy:** If the candidate has not studied Philosophy as a subject in the previous qualifying examination then Psychology/ Math/ Education/ Sociology/ Political Science be treated as related subjects.

\*\*\* Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational examination conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education and Training shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.A. (General) 1<sup>st</sup> year Course of Studies taking the subjects under Humanities Division only. However, candidates who have passed the aforesaid H.S. Examination in Business & Commerce shall also be eligible for admission to the B.Com.(General) 1<sup>st</sup> year Course of Studies under this University.

- i) **Bengali:** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects + % Marks in Bengali
- ii) **English:** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects +  $4 \times \%$  Marks in English
- iii) **Hindi:** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects + % Marks in Hindi
- iv) **History:** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects +  $2 \times \%$  Marks in History or  $2 \times \%$  Marks in English (if History is not studied then consider % Marks in English)
- v) **Political Science:** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects +  $2 \times \%$  Marks in Pol. Sc. or  $2 \times \%$  Marks in English (if Pol. Sc. is not studied then consider % Marks in English)
- vi) **Philosophy:** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects + % Marks in Philosophy or % Marks in Bengali/Hindi (if Philosophy is not studied then consider % Marks in Bengali/Hindi) +  $2 \times \%$  Marks in English
- vii) **Journalism and Mass Communication:** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects +  $2 \times \%$  Marks in English +  $2 \times \%$  Marks in either Bengali or Hindi or Journalism (whichever is higher), and if Hindi/ Bengali/ Journalism not studied at +2 level then English will be treated as the second subject also
- viii) **Physics:** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects +  $4 \times \%$  Marks in Physics +  $4 \times \%$  Marks in Mathematics
- ix) **Chemistry:** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects +  $4 \times \%$  Marks in Chemistry +  $2 \times \%$  Marks in Mathematics
- x) **Mathematics:** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects +  $2 \times \%$  Marks in Mathematics
- xi) **Computer Science:** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects +  $3 \times \%$  Marks in Mathematics
- xii) **Economics:** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects +  $4 \times \%$  Marks in Mathematics + % Marks in English
- xiii) **B.Com Honours (Accountancy):** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects + % Marks in Acc (if Acc not studied then % Marks in related subject)
- xiv) **B.A.(Gen):** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects
- xv) **B.Sc. General (Pure):** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects
- xvi) **B.Sc. General (Bio):** Aggregate of Best 4 subjects
- xvii) **B.Com. (General):** Aggregate of Best of 4 subjects
